(Genesis 1:1, John 3:16-18, John 14:16-26, and Psalms 100:2)

Salvation:

We believe in the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ! We believe that Jesus Christ died for our sins, and we believe that we have been saved by the blood of Jesus Christ! We believe that God sent Jesus Christ into the world for our sins, for our justification, and to save us from the pits of hell. We believe that it is because of Jesus, that we have been given a new life through Jesus Christ and that's because we have been saved and delivered by the blood of Jesus Christ!

(Isaiah 1:18, Galatians 2:20, Romans 8:1-3)

Discipleship:

We believe in the Great Commission in making disciples. The word "Disciple" in the Greek means: A learner and a follower of Jesus Christ, learning through instruction from the word of God. Then not just learning about becoming a disciple, but also putting it into action and becoming a disciple sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ and making more disciples to grow the Church, grow as believers, and then also growing to where we as disciples are committed to making other disciples for the glory, edification, and building up of the Kingdom of God.

Evangelism:

Missions:

We believe in being the Church, and we believe in being a Church that serves. As we are going forward, it's important as the Church to make sure that we are serving each other,

Baptism:

We believe that baptism is the profession of one's faith, to become saved and following the Lord and the word of God. Baptism is the mode and spirit of immersion, and we believe that one from their personal convictions must confess to the Lord and the Church that they desire to be baptized. Lord's Supper:

We believe that the Lord's Supper is the supper, that was instituted by Jesus Christ on the night before He was to be betrayed and crucified on the cross. We affirm that the bread is a representative of the broken body of Jesus Christ, and we affirm that the wine is the shed blood of Jesus Christ. We believe that the Lord's Supper is a crucial part of our Baptist Faith, and that it is a Holy Remembrance of what Jesus Christ did for us on Calvary and that Jesus Christ is coming back again for His Church.

Worship:

We believe in worship, we believe in praise, and we believe in glorifying the Lord Jesus Christ in Spirit and in Truth. We believe in being a body of believers that are centered around praising the Lord, because we know that the Lord is our Heavenly Father and that all praises belong to Him. Giving:

Holy Trinity:
